CLIMATE

Punta Cana boasts a tropical climate, loads of sunshine and high temperatures. March falls toward the end of the dry season in Punta Cana, when the temperatures begin to steadily rise and the amount of rainfall drops considerably. At this time of year, the average temperature is 26 degrees (C). Highs can reach as high as 30 degrees and low as 21 degrees.

DRESS

The **Conference is casual.** Feel free to leave the tie and jacket at home. You should bring light clothing for warmer weather. It can get breezy in the evenings, so bring a light sweater or jacket. The resort is expansive, comfortable footwear is highly recommended to get from place to place.

Please be aware that the resort does have dress codes depending on the time of day and which dining venue (see Dining Options) or activity.

Beach Casual - Shorts, capri pants, skirts, sneakers or sandals, flip-flops. Must wear a bathing suit wrap or cover-up and shirt at all times.

Resort Casual - Long pants, jeans, dress shorts and shirt or polo/collar shirt required for men. Shoes, tennis shoes or dress sandals. For women blouses, skirts, slacks or dresses, dress shoes or dress sandal. No sleeveless shirts or flip-flops allowed. No bathing suits allowed.

ELECTRICITY

The Dominican Republic electric outlets are 110 volts, the same as in the United States and Canada.



REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

A **valid passport** is required to enter Dominican Republic. Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months past your return date of travel. Legal names issued on your passport must match your itinerary and airline ticket.

We recommend that you make photocopies of page 2 of your passport. Leave copies with family members and carry copies with you on the trip in the event that your passport is lost or stolen.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE



1st bag - **FREE** (per person and/or booked seat) **2nd bag** - **\$35 CAD** (plus taxes)

Max. weight per bag: 23kg (50lb) Overweight fees for bags in excess of 23kg will apply. Baggage fees are your responsibility.

In general, each traveller will be allowed 1 carry-on bag that must fit in the overhead bin or under the seat in front of you, and one additional item, such as a briefcase or purse. Please do not pack sharp items such as nail scissors or pocket knives in your carry-on. They must be packed in your checked luggage.

CHECKING IN FOR YOUR FLIGHT

It's March Break so keep in mind airports will be busier than usual!

All airlines recommend recommend that you **arrive at the airport 3 hours prior to departure** for international flights. Please allow yourself enough time to check in and go through security. You can always call the airline or access the airline's website to check for schedule changes or flight delays and reconfirm the recommended check in time prior to leaving for the airport.

TOURIST CARD

A tourist card is **required to enter Dominican Republic** and will be provided at entry to the DR.


